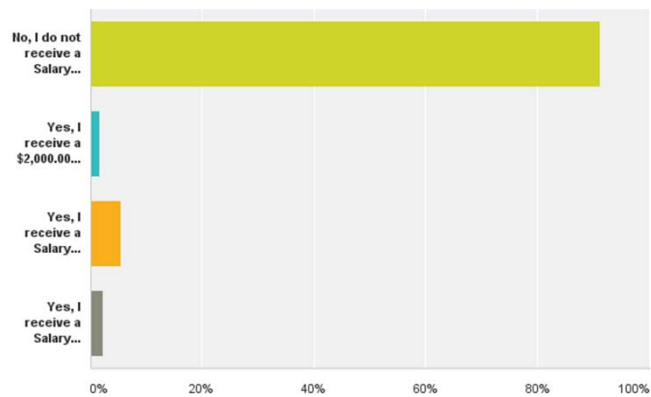

Q2 Does your employer provide a Salary Supplement for possession of the Certificate of Clinical Competence (CCC) through ASHA?

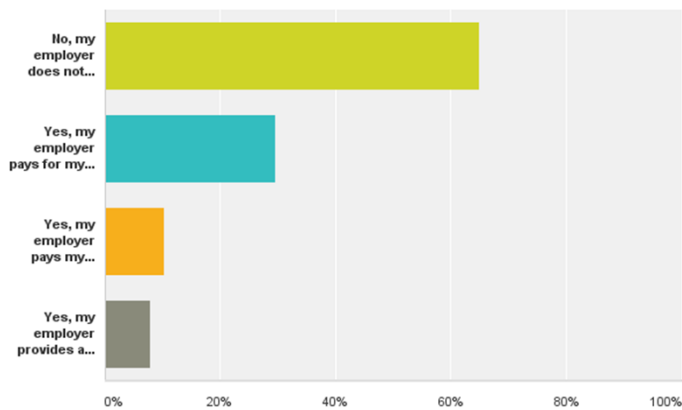
