Application and Supporting Documents Deadline: Postmarked by April 1, Awarded May 1. All applications and documents received after deadline date will be disqualified.

The minimum criteria to apply for KSHA's Student Research Grants are:

- 1. Transcript showing current GPA and enrollment in a speech-language pathology or audiology training program; undergraduate and graduate students are encouraged to apply
- 2. Financial need.
- 3. KSHA student membership.
- 4. Letters of Recommendation.
- 5. Letters of Support from any organization/group/employer/university, etc. included as part of the research study if applicable.
- 6. IRB Approval Letter
- 7. An essay (maximum of 500 words) detailing proposed research, financial need, and contribution of proposed research to the field.

Grant recipient agrees to:

- 1. Reference KSHA as a grant source when engaging in any media presentation.
- 2. Present research findings as a poster or podium presentation at the KSHA Convention.
- 3. Write a comprehensive article for the KSHA Publication *The Communicator* upon completion of the research study.

Please attach the following documentation to this application form:

- 1. Transcript to validate your GPA and program enrollment.
- 2. Current résumé showing your academic achievement, employment history, and relevant activities at either or both the graduate or undergraduate level.
- 3. Two Letters of Recommendation written on your school's letterhead. One **MUST** be from your Research Faculty Advisor and the second from your Program Faculty. The recommenders **MUST** address your financial situation, academic performance, your ability to conduct research, or other information relevant to your application.
- 4. Copy of Institutional Research Board (IRB) approval
- 5. Letters of Support (if applicable).
